











US SAILING'S JUNIOR CHAMPIONSHIPS

Information for HRYRA Sailors - 2014

US Sailing annually hosts the Smythe, Bemis, and Sears trophies for the US Sailing Junior Championships. HRYRA junior sailors that will turn at least 13, but not 19 in the calendar year are eligible.

To compete in the finals, you must qualify through our US Sailing area – Area B.

Singlehanded (Smythe trophy) – The single-handed Area B qualifier will be held on July 11th at Masons Island Yacht Club. It will be sailed in borrowed Byte CII's. HRYRA has FOUR boats reserved until July 2nd. Any junior that wants to attend should e-mail Peter Feroe by July 1st (pferoe@gmail.com). If more than four HRYRA juniors want to participate, HRYRA will choose the four based on resume. If four or less sailors want to participate, they may all go. More information on regatta website.

Doublehanded (Bemis trophy) – The doublehanded Area B qualifier will be held on July 11th at Masons Island Yacht Club. It will be sailed in BYOB Club 420's. Any HRYRA team that wishes to register and attend may do so – there are no limits. The top two eligible teams from the *Guy Moulton* will have their registration fees reimbursed by HRYRA. Triplehanded (Sears trophy) – The triplehanded Area B qualifier will be held on Friday, July 25th at the Waterfront Center in Oyster Bay, NY. It will be sailed in borrowed boats (J/22's?). Any junior that wants to attend should e-mail Peter Feroe by July 12th (pferoe@gmail.com). If more than one HRYRA team wants to participate, HRYRA will choose the team based on resume.
