Hudson River Long Distance Race

October 12, 2013 Notice of Race

Fourth annual distance race on the Hudson

1. RULES

The races will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.

2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

The race is open to all members of HRYRA that have a current HRYRA or YRA-LIS PHRF certificate. There will be two divisions, spinnaker and non-spinnaker. Eligible boats may enter by registering on line at <u>Hudson-River-Long-Distance-Race.org</u> Entries will be accepted at check-in. Check-in is in the NBC clubhouse.

3. ENTRY FEE

The entry fee is \$25. If not a US Sailing member, there is an additional \$5 fee.

4. SCHEDULE

There will be one race.

Saturday, October 12, 2012

0800 Registration

0900 Competitors meeting

1030 Spinnaker division warning signal

Non-Spinnaker signal will follow

Award Presentation after completion of racing.

5. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Sailing instructions will be available on the event site, <u>Hudson-River-Long-Distance-Race.org</u> and at checkin. In the event of a conflict between the Notice of Race and the Sailing Instructions, the Sailing Instructions will prevail. This modifies RRS 63.7.

6. VENUE

The racing area will be the part of the Hudson River between Piermont and Stony Point. The start and finish will be near the Nyack Boat Club.

7. PENALTY SYSTEM

The Scoring Penalty, RRS 44.3, will apply. The penalty will be 20% of the number of boats in the division that

checked in with the race committee, applied to the corrected time.

8. SCORING

The race will use the Time on Time PHRF scoring.

9. PRIZES

Trophies will be awarded to the top two boats in each division.

10. RADIO COMMUNICATION

- a. Boats shall use the VHF channel 78 to communicate with race committee as specified in the SI's.
- Except for these circumstances, a boat shall neither make radio transmissions while racing nor receive radio communications not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to cell phones.

11. MOORINGS

A limited number of moorings are available for guests. Submit request on registration form, or by emailing Eric Kent ahead of time. If anchoring, please do so north of the mooring field.

12. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

13. INSURANCE

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third party liability insurance.
