129th ANNUAL OPEN HRYRA REGATTA Saturday, September 7 & Sunday, September 8, 2013

** NOTICE OF RACE **

1. RULES

- 1.1. The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing.
- 1.2. The regatta Sailing Instructions incorporate the HRYRA Common Sailing Instructions, available at http://www.hryra.org/sites/default/files/2013%20HRYRA%20INSTRUCTIONS.v0.pdf which modify some of the Racing Rules of Sailing.

2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1. The regatta is open to all cruising classes that have a PHRF rating issued by HRYRA or YRALIS. There will be 4 classes as defined in 1.2 above (3 spinnaker based on PHRF, and 1 non-spinnaker.)
- 2.2. Eligible boats may register on line at www.shattemucyc.org/Race/SYC2013RegattaReg.htm, or by downloading the pdf registration form, completing and submitting or printing and mailing it to the indicated address, or by registering at the club house between 0900 and 1000 on September 7.
- 2.3. Late registrations may be accepted by the Race Committee at its discretion.

3. FEES

- 3.1. \$30 for USSailing Members, \$35 others. Additional \$5 if registering after September 2.
- 3.2. Fees for the associated Pig Roast dinner on Saturday, September 7 at 1830 are \$30 per person additional. You may make reservations on the registration form.
- 3.3. Mailed checks for on-line registrations must be received by Sept 5, or be hand-delivered on Sat., Sept. 7.

4. SCHEDULE

- 4.1. Timely registrations must be received by September 5, or hand-delivered on September 7, 0900-1000.
- 4.2. Two (2) Races are scheduled for Saturday, first gun at 1100; and two (2) races for Sunday, first gun at 1030.
- 4.3. For each class, the second race each day will be started as soon as practical after the last finisher of the class's previous race. Three sound signals and a VHF announcement will be made approximately 5 minutes before the race's warning signal.

5. MEASUREMENTS

5.1. Each boat shall have a currently valid PHRF certificate issued by HRYRA or by YRALIS.

6. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

6.1. The regatta sailing instructions will be available by September 5 on the Shattemuc web site: http://www.shattemucyc.org/activities/racing, and on the HRYRA web site: www.hryra.org.

7. VENUE

7.1. The racing area will be the waters of the Hudson River in the vicinity of Croton Point.

8. THE COURSES

- 8.1. The starting area will be on the Hudson River south of Croton Point.
- 8.2. Courses are listed in the Sailing Instructions.

9. PENALTY SYSTEM

9.1. The Scoring Penalty will apply as described in the HRYRA Common Sailing Instructions, 14.

10. SCORING & PRIZES

- 10.1. The regatta will be scored with no throw outs.
- 10.2. Awards will be made to the skippers and crew placing first, second, and third in each class having at least 3, 6, and 9 starters, respectively.

11. BERTHING

11.1.A limited number of berths are available in the marina or on moorings. Please contact the dock master (914-941-8777 Ext. 74 or 75) for assignment prior to use. Good anchoring is available to the north of the Club.

12. RADIO COMMUNICATION

- 12.1. Racers shall monitor VHF channel 72 for communications from the Race Committee.
- 12.2.Except in an emergency or notification to the Race Committee, a boat shall neither make nor receive radio transmissions while racing that are not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones.

13. LIABILITY DISCLAIMER

13.1.Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk: See rule 4, Decision to Race. Shattemuc Yacht Club will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.
